Sealed tenders are invited by the **Executive Officer, TTD, Tirupati** from the registered Farmer Associations in Tirupati / Chittoor Districts for supply of fresh Vegetables to Fourteen TTD Educational Institutions attached hostels and other TTD institutions, Tirupati and Tirumala for a period of one year. Tenderers who fulfil the following criteria are eligible to be evaluated.

- a. The tenderer should possess certificates such as Registration of Farmers Association, PAN card, GST registration etc.,
- b. The tenderer has to supply the vegetables to TTD Institutions attached hostels @ the rates not exceeding the rates of within Districts of Tirupati and Chittoor Rythu Bazaars, whichever is less. Participants in the tender must be in existence in the field of selling and supplying vegetables for the last 3 (three) years. Must be able to supply

approximately 1825 Kgs (1.82 ton) of different categories of vegetables daily to 14 TTD Institutions attached hostels at Tirupati and Tirumala as per indent.

- c. Preferably should have good track record of service in transporting and supply of vegetables with reputed organizations.
- d. Should be in a position to undertake the supply of vegetables within 15 days from the date of awarding contract / Agreement.

The tenderer who participates in the tender has to enclose the document cost of Rs.590.00 (Rupees five hundred and ninety only) (including GST) which is non-refundable, drawn by way of Demand draft drawn on any scheduled bank in favour of **"THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, TTD, TIRUPATI"** along with the Tender document.

- vi. Last 3 years' experience certificate towards supply of vegetables made to Government organizations, local bodies, reputed firms and organizations. The experience certificate shall be attested by the Head of the Organization/Institution/Agreement authority.
- vii. Should have capacity to supply 1825 Kgs (1.82 ton) of vegetables per day (Proof of supplied vegetables receipts must be enclosed).
- viii. Certificate should be produced from the Asst., Director of Horticulture of the respective Mandal giving the details of total No. of farmers in the Farmers Association, the total extent of agricultural land being cultivated, the items of vegetables produced and etc.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams invites applications from registered Farmers associations in Tirupati / Chittoor districts for the supply of Vegetables to 14 TTD Institutions attached hostels at Tirupati and Tirumala for a period of one year, on option/satisfaction of TTD it can be renewable for another one year and in any case not exceeding 03 (three) years. The intending Tender is made on the following criteria.

- a. T.T.D desires to procure fresh Vegetables at the rates shall not exceeding the rates within Districts of Tirupati and Chittoor Rythu Bazaars, whichever is less. The tenderer can also quote further discount in respect of supply of vegetables.
- b. Since transportation charges up to Rythu bazaar is included in the rates fixed by them, the transportation charges payable from Tirupati Rythu Bazaar to respective places alone will be paid by TTD. The distance from Tirupati Rythu Bazaar to various places is fixed by TTD and the Tenderer has to quote only per km transportation rate.
- c. In all the above cases of supply of vegetables and transportation of vegetables in and around Tirupati and Tirumala, the least rate payable by TTD for the supply of vegetables and transportation is the deciding factor for tender finalization.

1. Terms of Reference:

The Qualitative Requirements of this contract are as follows and only those Farmers Associations which fulfil the following criteria are eligible to be evaluated. Further, it is to be noted that those associations not fulfilling the following criteria will be summarily rejected the tenderer from participating in tender process. The decision of the TTD is final and binding on the Tender without any recourse.

- a. The tenderer should possess certificates such as Registration of Farmers Association, PAN card, GST registration etc.
- b. The tenderer has to supply the vegetables to TTD Institutions attached hostels @ the rates as approved by TTD for a period of one year from the date of awarding the contract.
- c. The Tenderer shall continue to supply vegetables at the accepted contract rates beyond the stipulated contract period, if so required by

TTD, until the tender process for the succeeding contract period is finalized and a new supplier commences the supply, without claiming any enhancement in rates or additional charges.

- d. Must be experience in the field of selling and supplying Vegetables for the last 03 (three) years.
- e. Must be able to supply approximately 1825 Kgs (1.82 ton) of different varieties of vegetables daily to TTD Institutions attached hostels at Tirupati and Tirumala as per indents of the concerned Principal/Chief warden/authorized Officials.
- f. Should have good track record of service in transporting and supply of vegetables with reputed organizations.
- g. Should be in a position to undertake the supply within 15 days from the date of awarding contract.
- h. Earnest Money deposit (E.M.D) is exempted.
- i. Security Deposit of Rs.1,00,000.00 (Rupees one lakh only) shall be paid by the successful tenderer/contractor in favor of the Executive Officer, TTD by way of Demand Draft from any of the Nationalized banks at the time of agreement.
- j. The successful Tenderer shall deposit a Security Deposit of Rs.30,000/- each (total of Rs.60,000/-) in favour of the Executive Officer, TTD, Tirupati, towards S.V. Vedic University, TTD, Tirupati and S.V. Poor Home, TTD, Tirupati, respectively. Since the said institutions are not under the administrative control of the Office of the Devasthanams Educational Officer, TTD, the Tenderer shall co-ordinate with the Registrar, S.V. Vedic University, TTD, Tirupati and the Chief Superintendent, S.V. Poor Home, TTD, Tirupati, for execution of the agreement and compliance with the contract conditions relating to those institutions.
- k. The Successful Tenderer shall supply the required Vegetables to 14 TTD Institutions attached hostels at Tirupati and Tirumala located at following distance from Tirupati Rythu Bazaar.

- The sealed covers shall be superscripted as **“Tenders for supply of Vegetables to TTD Institutions attached hostels and other TTD institutions”** will be received up to **3.00 P.M on 21-08-2026** and opened on the same day at **3.30 P.M** in the chamber of the Devasthanam Educational Officer, TTD, Tirupati in the presence of the Officers authorized by the Executive Officer, T.T. Devasthanams, Tirupati.
- The Vegetables should be supplied to the respective TTD Institutions attached hostels in suitable containers with good condition.
- The successful Tenderer/contractor should be in touch with the respective colleges to collect the indent every day from all TTD Institutions attached hostels i.e., a day before the supply of Vegetables.
- The successful Tenderer/contractor should supply fresh vegetables of good quality as per time schedule (to be communicated to them) and also the quantity as per the indents placed by the concerned hostel authorities.
- The quality and freshness of Vegetables should confirm to the satisfaction of the concerned Principal/Chief Warden/authorized officials Tirupati and Tirumala as the case may be.
- If the supplied Vegetables are not up to the standard with regard to quality, weight, freshness etc., during the verification by the concerned/ food analyst at the time of delivery of the Vegetables, the same will be rejected and the required Vegetables will be purchased from the open market and the difference of cost if any will be recovered from the successful tenderer/contractor while making payment.
- The successful Tenderer/contractor should supply vegetables continuously whenever required to the institutions throughout the Tender period and bear

- all the charges such as loading & unloading, labour charges etc. till the delivery of vegetables reached to the required destinations.
9. The SD amount will be refunded only after satisfactory completion of the contract period. The amount of any due to TTD will be recovered from Security Deposit. No interest will be paid on the Security Deposit amounts.
 10. The Chief Vigilance and Security Officer, TTD, Tirupati will permit the Lorries of vegetables to travel from Tirupati to Tirumala duly collecting usual toll fee fixed by the TTD from time to time.
 11. The transportation of the Vegetables to the TTD Institutions attached hostels and other TTD institutions concerned with in the time shall be at the risk and responsibility of the contractor and he should make his own transport arrangements.
 12. Any request from the successful tenderer/contractor to increase the rates of vegetables/transportation charges due to increase of fuel rate or due to any other unforeseen circumstances will not be entertained at any cost and there would not be any legality to Contest for the issue.
 13. If the Tenderer fails to supply as per the indent placed by the concerned Principal/Chief warden penalty will be imposed and will be recovered from the bills payable as detailed below.

14. Note:

- a. No penalty will be imposed if they supply 90% of the indented vegetables or more.
 - b. If they supply 81% to 89 % of the indented, 10% of the total bill amount will be deducted as penalty.
 - c. If they supply 71% to 80% of the indented, 20% of the total bill amount will be deducted as penalty.
 - d. If they supply 70% and less than the indented vegetables 30% of the total amount will be deducted as penalty.
15. If the Farmers Association fails to supply the vegetables on any day, the required vegetables will be purchased from Rythu Bazaar, Tirupati /open market. The amount will be deducted from the future bills as a measure of penalty.
 16. The Tenderers who are in arrears / dues to TTD and the persons having criminal record, persons whose earlier Tender was cancelled for violation of terms and conditions of Tender are liable to be summarily rejected. And if it comes to the notice of the T.T.D. at a later date that particular Tenderer is having any of the above disqualifications, then the Tender orders issued will be cancelled immediately without any notice duly forfeiting the Security Deposit paid by the tenderer.
 17. In respect of **S.V. Vedic University, TTD, Tirupati** and **S.V. Poor Home, TTD, Tirupati**, the successful Tenderer shall execute separate agreements with the respective Heads of the Institutions and shall be bound by the terms and conditions contained therein. The Security Deposit, payment of bills, settlement of arrears, recovery of dues, if any, and all other contractual obligations shall be regulated and settled exclusively between the respective Head of the Institution and the Tenderer.
 18. The Office of the Devasthanams Educational Officer, TTD, Tirupati shall have no administrative or financial responsibility in respect of the Security Deposit, payment of bills, settlement of arrears, recovery of dues, or any other

contractual matters relating to the supply of vegetables to **S.V. Vedic University, TTD, Tirupati** and **S.V. Poor Home, TTD, Tirupati**. All such matters shall be dealt with exclusively between the respective Head of the Institution and the Tenderer.

19. The RFP/Tender Document shall be made available on the official TTD website (www.tirumala.org) from **23-07-2026** to **21-08-2026** up to **12.00 Noon**. Interested Tenderers may download the Tender Document from the website during the above period.
20. The Tenderer who downloads the Tender Document and participates in the tender shall enclose a non-refundable Tender Document Fee of Rs.590/- (Rupees Five Hundred and Ninety only), inclusive of GST, in the form of a Demand Draft drawn on any Scheduled Bank in favour of "**The Executive Officer, TTD, Tirupati**", along with the Tender Document.
21. The completed Tender Document, together with all required enclosures, shall be submitted in the Office of the Devasthanams Educational Officer, TTD, 2nd Floor, TTD Administrative Building, Room No.325, K.T. Road, Tirupati, on or before **21-08-2026 up to 3.00 P.M.** The tenders so received will be opened on the same day at 3.30 P.M. in the presence of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives who choose to be present.

Note: The Tender Document Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

RATES:

- a. The Tenderer shall quote the discount percentage (%) on the prevailing vegetable rates (per kilogram) notified by the Rythu Bazaars. The payable rate for each item shall be arrived at after applying the quoted discount to the rates prevailing in the Rythu Bazaars of Tirupati or Chittoor Districts, whichever is lower.
- b. The Tenderer shall also quote the transportation charges per kilometre from Tirupati Rythu Bazaar to the destination institutions specified by TTD (as indicated in Clause.
- c. The distance from Tirupati Rythu Bazaar to each destination institution shall be as fixed by TTD, and the Tenderer shall quote the transportation rate per kilometre accordingly.
- d. Note: The lowest evaluated bid shall be determined based on the combined effect of the discount quoted on the vegetable rates and the transportation charges quoted by the Tenderer.
- e. The rates quoted shall be firm and inclusive of all taxes, duties, loading, unloading, labour charges, handling charges, packing, transportation and all other incidental expenses required for supplying vegetables to the TTD College Attached Hostels and other institutions covered under this tender.
- f. The rates accepted by TTD shall remain firm and valid throughout the contract period and shall not be subject to any revision or escalation on any account whatsoever during the currency of the contract.
- g. The rates should be written in figures and words and the Tenders with overwriting, alterations etc., would not be admitted unless they are attested by the concerned, where there is a discrepancy between in figures and in words, least rate payable by TTD will govern.
- h. Tenderer is required to sign the declaration on Tender forms in duplicate indicating date and affixing the rubber stamp with the designation (or) status

enjoyed by the signatory in the firm and the same signatory shall be required to execute agreement under his signature only.

- i. In case change of the person of the signatory, it is bound on the Tenderer to inform the changes to the TTD, the signatory should produce documentary evidence of empowering him to do so, if called upon at any time during the contract period.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

22. The successful Tenderer/Contractor shall, at the time of execution of the agreement, deposit a Security Deposit of **Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only)** by way of Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank at Tirupati in favour of **"THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, TTD, TIRUPATI"** towards the institutions under the administrative control of the Office of the Devasthanams Educational Officer, TTD.
23. In addition, the successful Tenderer/Contractor shall deposit **Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) each (a total of Rs. 60,000-00)** towards S.V. Vedic University, TTD, Tirupati and S.V. Poor Home, TTD, Tirupati, as Security Deposit, in accordance with the terms and conditions governing those institutions, since they are not under the administrative control of the Office of the Devasthanams Educational Officer, TTD. The Security Deposits and all contractual obligations relating to these two institutions shall be governed separately by the respective Heads of the Institutions.
24. The Successful tenderer/contractor shall execute an agreement with all the terms and conditions specified on a non-judicial stamp Paper worth not less than of **Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only)** before the commencement of the contract.
25. Any dispute arising out of this tender shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of both parties. If no such mutual consent arrives, any party can approach the Court of Law for appointment of Arbitrator as per the procedure prescribed under Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. He shall dispose of the same as per the provisions of Arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments made there under from time to time. The place of Arbitration proceedings shall be at Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh. The Arbitrator's fee and other expenses shall be borne by both parties equally.
26. In the event of failure in Arbitration, Any legal issues shall alone have exclusive Jurisdiction of Tirupati Courts and High Court of AP only for any dispute arising out of this tender.
27. The TTD reserves the right for inclusion (or) exclusion of the other terms and conditions in the interest of TTD without specifying further intimation.
28. The Executive Officer/Devasthanam Educational Officer, TTD, Tirupati reserves the right to give preference to any Farmer Association in the interest of the organization at any time before and after the acceptance of the tender and the decision of the Executive Officer, TTD is final and binding on Tenderer without any recourse.
29. The TTD reserves the right to cancel/terminate and recover liquidate damages from the Tenderer/Contractor for failing to fulfil the terms of the contract as follows:

- a. In case the successful Tenderer/Contractor back out/ withdraws after releasing the letter of intent (or) fails to supply vegetables within the period to be prescribed by the Devasthanam Educational Officer, TTD, Tirupati at the time of placing orders, the contractor will be liable to the loss sustained by the TTD in addition to the following:
 - b. TTD shall be entitled to choose any other Farmer Association (or) any agency for supply of vegetables without issuing notice to the successful tenderer who failed to supply the vegetables as per the requirement on the first instance and to recover the extra cost thus incurred in purchasing the vegetables from any other Farmer Association or agency, from the tenderer.
 - c. TTD also reserves the right to cancel the contract (or) portion thereof and the decision of the Executive Officer/Devasthanam Educational Officer in this regard shall be final and binding on the parties without any recourse.
 - d. TTD reserves the right to forfeit the SD to the extent of the loss Incurred by TTD in the event of action being taken under (a) & (b) and of any short fall, the TTD shall be at liberty to recover such amount with legal charges as per law.
30. TTD reserves the right to charge penalty as decided under clause 12 (or) withhold payment for any unsatisfactory service rendered by the Contractor/ Supplier without prejudice to its other rights. In this regard, the decision of the Devasthanam Educational Officer is final.
31. All prohibitory Items applicable to TTD as a whole and in sacred Tirumala Hills in particular have to be followed strictly by the Contractor/supplier. Further it is to inform to the Tenderer that, under Section 114 of Act 30 of 1987 any person contravening any prohibitory items in this regard shall be punishable by the TTD/Law.
- a. Possession, use (or) consumption of any intoxicating liquor or drug or cigarettes and other prohibited items;
 - b. Possession, preparation or consumption of meat or other food stuffs containing meat;
 - c. Slaughter, killing or maiming any animal or bird for any reason;
 - d. Gaming with cards, dice, counters, money or other instruments of gaming;
 - e. Dealing in any manner with Seva ticket, Prasadam and accommodation belonging to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams except at such places and by persons specially authorized in this behalf by him.
 - f. The Tenderer/Supplier shall be Hindu by religion and contractor's supplying staff should also be Hindu Religion only. If, any of its deployed staff for supply vegetables to Tirumala hills is a non-Hindu, he/she should give Declaration to TTD at Alipiri Toll Gate and he is Strictly Prohibited from offering his/her religious prayers at Tirumala.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

Day wise claim with bill amount should be raised by the Contractor/ Supplier Farmer Association name only.

Bank account details of the claimer including PAN (Xerox copy to be enclosed).

The above document required is not exhaustive and it is to be specifically noted that without the above document, the claims bills of Supplier shall not be processed by the TTD. Statutory deductions as per rules will be borne by the contractor and they will be deducted from the monthly bill.

PAYMENT:-

The payment will be made to the rates arrived on calculation of discount offered in %(Percentage) on each item of the vegetable rates (Per Kg) of within Districts of **Tirupati / Chittoor Rythu Bazaars**, whichever is less by the end of the month by way of cheque only. All statutory deductions applicable at the time shall be made from the payment. No advance will be paid against the supplied vegetables.

Note: The rates available within Districts of **Tirupati / Chittoor Rythu Bazaars**, website will be taken as criteria (or) certified by the Estate Officers, Rythu Bazaar, Tirupati & Chittoor Districts. If any day of the Rythu Bazaar falls holiday on the day of supply of vegetables, then the previous day rates should be taken during raising the bill.

The transportation charges will be paid per trip on calculation of agreed rates per Km subject to the total distance prescribed under clause.2.

- a. At any time, prior to the date of submission of Tender, the TTD may modify the tender documents by amendments for any reason, whether at its own
